

CASING SWAGE

DESCRIPTION

The Casing Swage is designed with a long tapered nose and consists of an economical mean for re-opening collapsed sections of casing or to control the clearance of a casing.

USE

It is requiring a mechanical force creating an impact for reopening casing obstructions. This is why it is usually run with a safety joint, drill collar, bumper sub and jar.

It may be necessary to run a series of larger and larger swages, in order to gradually bring the damaged section back to its initial round form.

Specify :

- Diameter and weight (lbs/ft) of your casings
